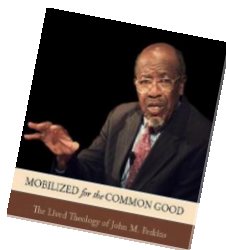

Dr. John M. Perkins is a world renowned and a much in demand author, lecturer, pastor, and civil rights leader. Born in Mississippi, reared with barely a third grade education by his grandmother on a sharecropper's farm, and nearly martyred as a young man, Dr. Perkins life was transformed by his accepting Jesus Christ. Since that time Dr. Perkins has dedicated his life to racial reconciliation, leadership training, and Christian Community development. Among his nine popular books are *A Quiet Revolution*, *Let Justice Roll Down*, *With Justice For All*, *Beyond Charity*, *He's My Brother*, *Resurrecting Hope*, and *A Time to Heal*. He is president of the John and Vera Mae Perkins Foundation, a co-founder and board member of the Christian Community Development Association, a partner with Seattle Pacific University while serving on many other national and international boards.

About the Launch Out Conference

The idea for the Launch Out Conference was born from Christ's command to Peter in Luke 5: 4-5. Understanding believers called by Christ to carry out a task or mission sometime experience doubt, fear, or even intimidation but convinced by Luke 5 that Christ blesses faithful obedience, Ministers (at that time) Anthony and Dawn embraced and internalized the message in "Nevertheless at thy Word." In doing so, they realized such a powerful message is one that modern day believers should be reminded of periodically as they navigate in a world filled with uncertainties and deceptions. Prayerfully inspired to launch out themselves, Pastors Anthony and Dawn initiated the first Launch Out conference in 2010. Since that time, they have made an effort to invite guests who themselves have "nevertheless launched out" when called and have thereby accomplished extraordinary feats through faithful obedience to Christ.
